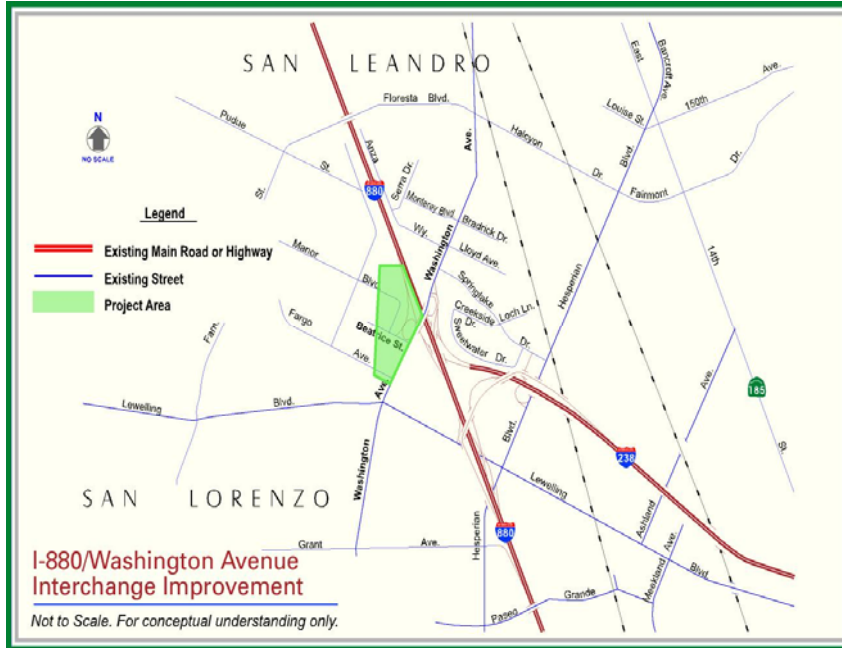


I-880/Washington Avenue Interchange Improvement ACTIA 11

Project Description:

The project involves improving access between Washington Avenue and I-880. The initial phase improvements include widening the southbound I-880 on-ramp, modifying the signals along Washington Avenue at Beatrice Street and Fargo Avenue, and widening northbound Washington Avenue to accommodate increased turning movements.

Project Status Report

Caltrans and the City of San Leandro have reached agreement to construct the project in phases. The City will construct the I-880/Washington Avenue on-ramp and intersection improvements. Design and Right-of-Way (ROW) activities are being finalized. The City of San Leandro will administer the construction. Caltrans will widen the I-880/ Washington Avenue off-ramp as funding becomes available. The City of San Leandro has combined this project with its federally funded Washington Avenue overlay project. The construction contract was awarded in February 2009 (approximately 17% below Engineer's Estimate), with completion scheduled for May 2010.
