

# LAVTA Livermore Senior Housing Shuttle Project

*East County*



**PROJECT BENEFITS:**

The LAVTA Senior Housing Shuttle connects residents to other fixed-route services, enabling them to take transit throughout the Tri-Valley area, and to get to key destinations easily and safely.

**T**his grant funds a contract to operate services for the Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority (LAVTA) Livermore Senior Housing Shuttle, which connects four senior housing centers and the Livermore Veterans Hospital with the Livermore Transit Center. The shuttle brings residents to key destinations such as the post office and the Livermore Civic Center, as well as gives riders better access to fixed-route services.

Accessible bus stops are included in the route, as well as connections to the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) services and other transit opportunities.

**PROJECT UPDATE:**

LAVTA continues to operate the Livermore Senior Housing shuttle on its route that serves as a feeder from the senior living facilities to the trunk lines of the Wheels system.
