Mission

Improve the walking and biking environment for everyone in Alameda County by having a regular, ongoing forum for public agency and non-profit staff whose work impacts the bicycle and pedestrian environment.

PBWG Workslope (Roles)

1. Share information on bicycle and/or pedestrian issues of importance to the entire county or to multiple agencies, such as:
 - a. Successful implementation of projects/programs/policies
 - b. Emerging trends/needs/policies
 - c. New innovative infrastructure treatments
 - d. New programs being developed and launched
 - e. Challenges faced in implementing/installing/operating/maintaining facilities or programs
2. Provide input on the establishment and implementation of countywide bicycle/pedestrian programs and resources.
3. Develop best practices and possibly policy positions on bicycle/pedestrian issues through the broad-based knowledge and experience of the group.
4. Coordinate efforts to implement continuous bicycle networks and pedestrian facilities of countywide significance (i.e. across jurisdictional boundaries).
5. Allow opportunities for networking among group members.

Local agency and non-profit staff working to improve the walking and bicycling environment.
