

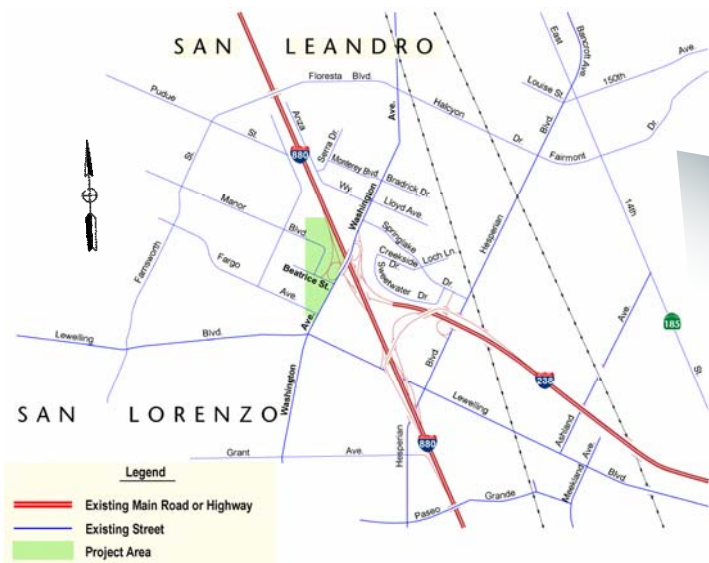
# I-880/Washington Avenue Interchange

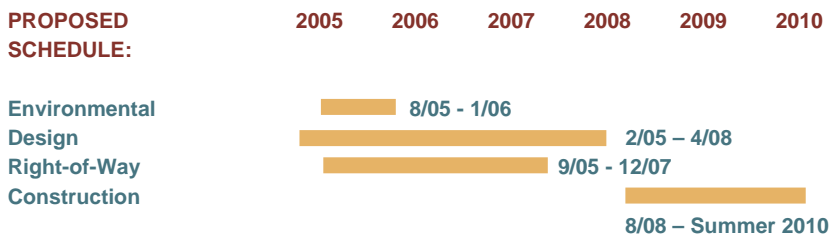


**P**ROVIDING LOCAL improvements in San Leandro at Washington and Fargo Avenues and Beatrice Street, this project improves local access to Southbound I-880. These improvements will help alleviate traffic congestion on local City streets during morning rush hour.

### THE PROJECT WILL:

- Widen the southbound I-880/Washington Avenue on-ramp
- Modify the Washington Avenue signals at Beatrice Street and Fargo Avenue
- Add a double left turn lane on northbound Washington Avenue at Beatrice Street

### STATUS UPDATE:

Caltrans and the City of San Leandro has reached agreement to construct the project in phases. The City will construct the I-880/Washington on-ramp and intersection improvements. Design, Right-of-Way activities and utility relocation are complete. The City of San Leandro will administer construction which is anticipated to begin in August 2008. Caltrans will widen the I-880/Washington off-ramp as funding becomes available.
