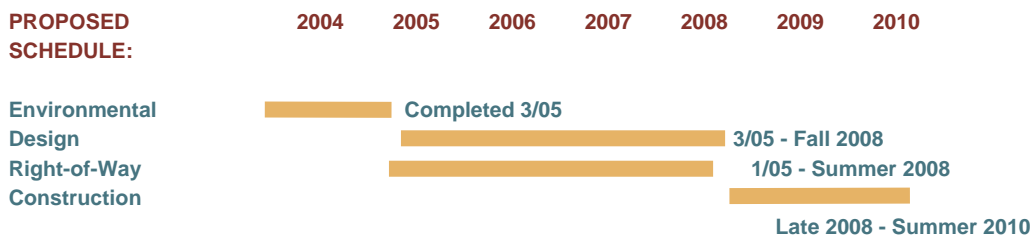


LEWELLING BOULEVARD is a heavily traveled local thoroughfare. The project will widen the street to provide additional capacity, reducing local congestion, and will provide improved facilities for bicyclists and pedestrians.

THE PROJECT MAY INCLUDE:

- Widening Lewelling /East Lewelling Boulevard between Hesperian Boulevard and Meekland Avenue from two lanes to four lanes
- Constructing a median island, curbs, gutters, sidewalks and bicycle lanes

STATUS UPDATE:

Alameda County has completed the final plan line study and prepared a Project Study Report (PSR). The Environmental Document was approved by the County Board of Supervisors on March 22, 2005. Design and right-of-way activities are being completed. This project is part of a larger planned project to widen East Lewelling Boulevard to East 14th Street.
