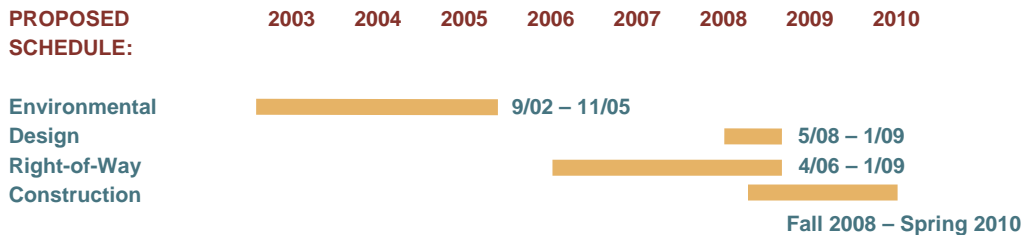

THIS HEAVILY TRAVELED intersection serves as the local connection from surface streets to I-580.

THE PROJECT includes:

- Constructing a second left turn lane on southbound East 14th Street at 150th Avenue
- Constructing a bus stop pocket followed by a right turn pocket on southbound East 14th Street at 150th Avenue
- Modifying the southbound lane on Hesperian Boulevard to provide a second northbound left turn lane at East 14th Street
- Modifying the through and left turn lane on southbound Bancroft Avenue to provide a dedicated left turn lane at East 14th Street
- Acquiring center triangle-shaped parcel, removing existing improvements and installing landscaping

The City of San Leandro has completed the Scoping Summary Report. The report identifies the proposed project, the estimated project cost and proposed implementation schedule. Environmental clearance was obtained in November 2005. The City is monitoring ground water conditions, which is required for right-of-way acquisition.
