

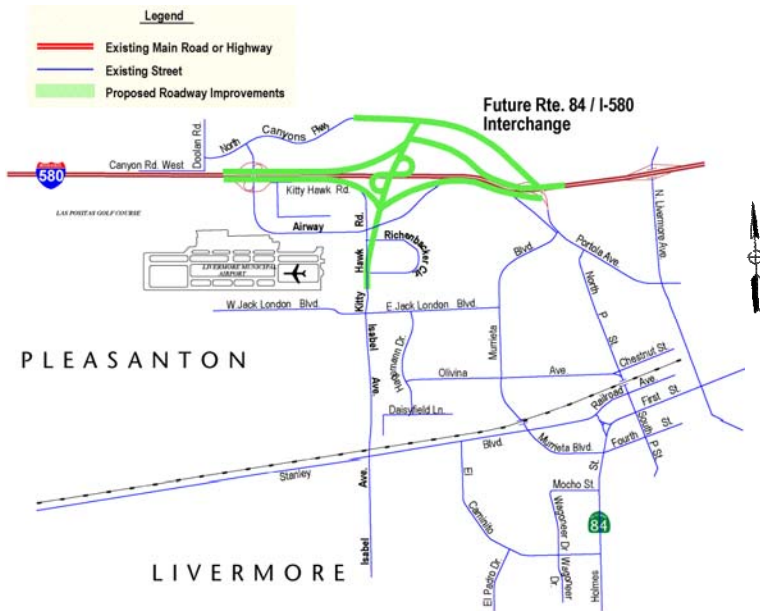
Route 84/I-580 Interchange

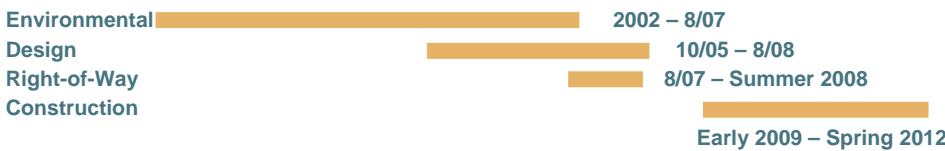


THIS PROJECT will provide a direct link from I-580 to the Isabel Avenue extension, adopted as the replacement Route 84 in Livermore. It will also accommodate traffic from the approved development in the northwest quadrant of the City.

THE PROJECT WILL:

- Construct a partial cloverleaf interchange at the extension of Isabel Avenue and I-580
- Construct Isabel Avenue north of Rickenbacker Circle North and Portola Avenue
- Extend/reconstruct Portola Avenue from East Airway Boulevard to Isabel Avenue, including a new Portola Avenue overcrossing.
- Realign East Airway Boulevard between Kitty Hawk Road and Sutter Street

STATUS UPDATE:

The project will be constructed in three segments. Caltrans will award and administer the interchange segment and the City of Livermore will award and administer the northern and southern segments of local roads.

The Modified Access Report was approved by FHWA in March 2005. The Caltrans' Project Report has been signed. The environmental document was completed on November 9, 2007.

Design and Right-of-Way acquisition will be completed in Summer 2008. Construction will begin in early 2009.
