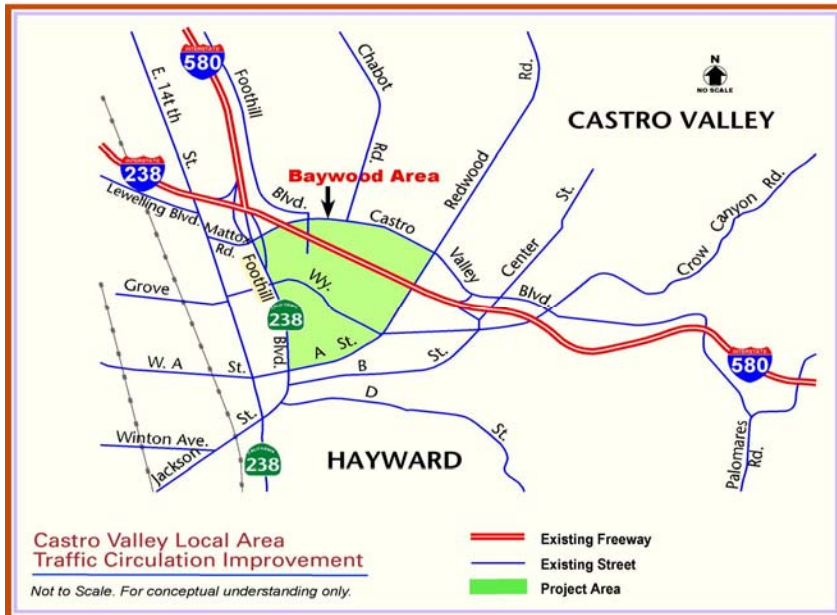

Project Description:

Providing local improvements in the Baywood area of Unincorporated Alameda County, this project will help alleviate traffic congestion and reduce regional bypass and cut through traffic on numerous arterial, collector and local roads.

Project Status Report:

In July 2005, the ACTA Board adopted Amendment No. 1 to the 1986 Expenditure Plan which deleted the Route 238 (Hayward Bypass) Project and added four projects, including this project. On May 9, 2006, the Alameda County Board of Supervisors endorsed a list of potential projects in the Baywood area for use of Measure B funds. A funding agreement for the scoping phase for the program of projects has been developed.

Recent Activities:

- County staff is moving forward with scoping activities. A draft scope of work has been prepared for ACTA staff review. The Project Specific Funding agreement is being executed.
- The County made a presentation regarding their alternative recommendation to Castro Valley Municipal Advisory Council (CVMAC) on March 16, 2009 and made a follow-up presentation to CVMAC on September 21, 2009.
