Energize Your Commute on May 14th – Bike-to-Work Day

ALAMEDA COUNTY - California. Thursday, May 14th is Bike to Work Day, when the East Bay Bicycle Coalition (EBBC) will coordinate over 200 Energizer Stations to encourage bicycle ridership. Stations will be located along local bike commute routes throughout Alameda County providing free beverages, snacks and good cheer to bicyclists.

As a special addition in Alameda County, Chipotle Mexican Grill will provide a coupon, which is good for a free burrito and chips. When they stop at evening Energizer Stations, riders will receive a coupon, which they can exchange for a burrito at local Chipotle restaurants. Coupons will be honored through Friday, May 15, 2009.

Energizer Stations will be open during morning commute hours and some will re-open during the evening commute as well. This year marks the 15th anniversary of the San Francisco Bay Area's Bike to Work Day. In Alameda County Bike to Work Day is funded in part by the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority's (ACTIA) Measure B funds.

On Bike to Work Day, as many as 50,000 to 100,000 people are expected to bike to work in the Bay Area, with many being first-time bike commuters. The EBBC and ACTIA are encouraging everyone to spare the air and engage in active transportation, as bicycling is a low-impact means of transportation. Active Transportation in Alameda County includes advancing bicycle and pedestrian to transit, connecting communities through urban

greenways, and inspiring people to walk and bike through Safe Routes to Schools and Safe Routes for Seniors programs.

The EBBC is a non-profit, tax-exempt 501(c)3 organization dedicated to promoting bicycling as an everyday means of transportation and recreation. The EBBC safeguards the interest of bicyclists in Alameda and Contra Costa counties.

ACTIA administers Measure B, the half cent transportation sales tax in Alameda County, which was approved by 81.5% of the voters. ACTIA delivers transportation improvements and services to keep Alameda County moving, including mass transit projects and programs, transit villages, bicycle and pedestrian corridors, and key highway projects to eliminate bottlenecks and improve local connectivity.
